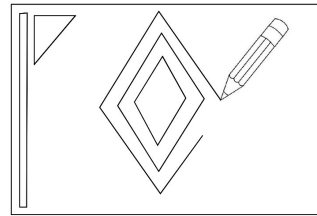


Making a medieval tapestry.

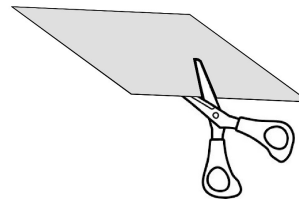
In the medieval period, brightly coloured embroidered fabrics known as tapestry were used as decoration and were sometimes incorporated into the robes of the clergy.

We can create a tapestry style image using brightly coloured paper, with silver and gold foil to represent silver and gold embroidery.

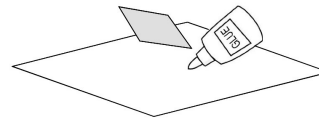
On a piece of coloured paper that you have chosen as your background, sketch a picture or pattern, or perhaps a picture with a patterned border.



Now cut pieces of different coloured paper to colour in your design.



These are glued onto your design.



Over the top of this add small pieces of silver or gold foil to make your design shine.

You may want to work as a group and create a little story for a display.
