

## A medieval village church.


In the video we talked about the way that village and parish churches were highly decorated.

As a group we are going to decorate a model of a village church.


In the middle of the group should be the shell of a model church made from a cardboard box from the supermarket.

As a group discuss where the doors and windows should go and which part of the church has the altar in it. Then take it in turns to choose a wall to decorate.

Carefully measure the wall and draw the shape of it on a piece of paper.



Mark where the doors and windows should go.



Now you can fill in the remaining area with decorations depending on where in the church it goes.

The insides of walls will be white with brightly coloured picture painted on them. The outsides of walls will be stone coloured and have gargoyles, statues and carvings on them. The windows will be particularly decorative. Don't forget the floor?

Once the decorations have been painted on paper, they can be cut out and glued onto the cardboard to create a colourful display model.
